

1. Varnishes used to paint loft ladders' hatches of sandwich type

For varnishing hatches of loft ladders (the loft ladder's hatch is finished with HDF board) use chemical varnishes, preferably polyurethane ones.

Varnish application order:

- 1.1 Chemical primer (one or two layers) according to manufacturer's recommendations – polyurethane primer featuring good sandability.
- 1.2 Sanding with a fine sandpaper and removing dust from the coating.
- 1.3 Chemical polyurethane varnish in any RAL or NCS colour.

2. Methods for applying primer and varnish coatings

The loft ladder's hatch should be painted using:

- 2.1 Rollers with short fleece or spongelike as they greatly reduce splashing and the amount of the preparation used.
- 2.2 Natural or artificial brushes with soft bristle. Natural brush may lose bristle, therefore it is recommended to sand it with a sandpaper to soften its tips and remove loose hair before using.
- 2.3 Varnish spraying.
